Canteen Subsidy Under Threat ?

Head Office staff have shown their opposition to the massive price increases which have been levied from the beginning of April in the staff restaurant. 320 staff have signed a petition



organised by UNISON stewards at Head Office calling for the withdrawal of the new tariff structure and the canteen users

creation of a canteen users committee.

The new tariff structure means the prices for most popular meals have rocketed 60% at a time when inflation is meant to be almost non-existant.

Management reject petition

However at Head Office managers response to the petition and a formal request from staff representatives for a discussion about tariffs and canteen operation was to **reject** them. So much for the slogan 'Working together, Sharing the future'.

This point blank refusal to meet staff representatives to discuss canteen operations means that there is no means by which the £250,000 canteen

subsidy can be monitored to ensure it's value is maintained.

UNISON representatives have



therefore organised a meeting for **all Head Office** staff to decide whether we should organise a boycott of the canteen.
